But beware online "deals." My buddy in Texas ordered mounts labeled "container-ready" that couldn't handle his roof pitch. Return shipping cost more than the mounts themselves. Total cheugy move.

Real Price Examples & Installation Scenarios

Let's break down two real-life situations. First: Sarah in Colorado needed mounts for a 40ft container. She got solar panel mounts for shipping containers locally at \$155 each--\$1,860 total. But wait! Her installer charged \$950 extra for reinforcing the roof. Ouch. Second: Diego near Miami ordered identical EcoFasten mounts online for \$122/unit but spent \$380 on hurricane-proof brackets. Both paid ~\$2,800 total. See how location changes everything?
