The Not-So-Distant Future

Looking beyond 2026 pricing, there's something more fundamental shifting. Municipalities are starting to treat solar containers like Lego blocks - stacking them vertically in urban areas. Berlin's pilot program along the Spree River uses stacked containers with vertical-axis turbines, achieving 190% space efficiency compared to traditional setups.
