Customs Chess Game

A Johannesburg importer recently paid R12,000 extra because they classified solar batteries as "electrical equipment" rather than "renewable energy components". These bureaucratic gotchas add up faster than you can say "VAT exemption".

The Hidden Costs of Going Mobile

Let's crunch actual 2023 numbers from a Western Cape installation:

Permit Fees R4,200
Ground Preparation R18,000
Anti-Theft System R9,500

Wait, no - that last figure should read R9,750. The point stands: The "mobile" part often anchors you to permanent security investments.

Community Quandary

In Soweto townships, installers now budget for:

Local workforce training (3-5 days)
Community liaison officers

Cultural context matters - you can't just drop tech and dash.

1. Hybrid Shipping: Mix sea and land transport
2. Buy local mounting structures
3. Pre-clear components separately

Johannesburg solar installer Nomsa Khumalo shares: "We cut clients' costs 18% by using South African-made trailers instead of importing full units."

- Panel cleaning
- Battery health checks
- Software updates
